ANNOUNCEMENT FOR THE INTERNATIONAL "MARIA S. THEOCHARI AWARD, 2021-2022" DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION, February 28, 2023

The Board of the Christian Archaeological Society with the kind sponsorship of the "Pericles S. Theocaris Foundation" is pleased to announce that the international "Maria S. Theochari Award", of 2.000 €, will be granted for eleventh time for the best scientific study in the field of Byzantine and - Post-Byzantine painting (4th century – 1830).

Books or papers published in distinguished journals of international circulation from **January 1**, **2021 to December 31**, **2022** can be submitted. There are no restrictions of age or nationality for the candidates. The Award will be announced during the Annual *Symposium of the Christian Archaeological Society* (Athens, May 5-7, 2023).

The books or papers should be submitted by **February 28, 2023** electronically and in two printed copies, one of which will be returned to the author after the completion of the procedure.

All submissions accompanied by an application letter, mentioning the affiliation and the name of the Award, should be sent to the Secretariat of the Christian Archaeological Society to the attention of Mrs. Sophia Giannioti (for the Maria S.
